Dr. Daniel H. Gordis is Vice President of the Mandel Foundation – Israel, and Director of the Mandel Leadership Institute in Jerusalem.

Prior to his family's making *aliyah* in 1999, Dr. Gordis served as Vice President for Public Affairs and Community Outreach at the University of Judaism in Los Angeles. He was also the founding Dean of the Ziegler Rabbinical School – the first rabbinical school on West Coast of the United States – and Assistant Professor of Philosophy. Dr. Gordis received his B.A. from Columbia College, a Masters Degree and Ordination from the Jewish Theological Seminary of America, and his Ph.D. from the University of Southern California.

In addition to the books listed here, Dr. Gordis has published numerous articles on issues related to the future of Jewish life in America, as well as Jewish law and ethics in such journals as *Conservative Judaism*, *Judaism Quarterly*, *Prooftexts*, *Tikkun*, *Modern Judaism*, *Moment Magazine*, *The Forward*, the *Jewish Spectator*, of which he served as Senior Contributing Editor for eight years, and the *New York Times Magazine*.

He resides with his wife, Elisheva, and their daughter and two sons in Jerusalem.
